Consultancy Overview

Free the Slaves is in the process of shifting some of its training and capacity building work to an online platform. The online training consultant will play a critical role in designing the online version of the FTS community liberation modules (toolkit), building online training and capacity strengthening tools, and supporting FTS in its organizational adaptation to expanding its online work and strategy. The online training consultant will work closely with the leadership and programmatic staff of Free the Slaves.

Responsibilities

The online training consultant will:

- Work with the South Asia regional director, senior program manager, and other FTS staff to modify Module 3 of the FTS Community Liberation Toolkit (Rule of Law Advocacy for NGOs) for use in an online pilot of the module
- Design online training versions of Module 1 (Educating and Mobilizing Vulnerable Communities) and Module 2 (Liberation, Care and Reintegration) of the FTS toolkit
- Support FTS in the development of its online strategy including training, and outreach for use of the toolkit
- Train FTS staff in the effective use of on-line tools and training methods
- Share with FTS innovative tools to ensure effective online trainings, including training methods and tactics

- Help build FTS capacity to effectively utilize its online presence to strengthen the capacity of the members of the movement against modern-day slavery

Qualifications

- 5+ years of progressively-increasing responsibility as a trainer, toolkit and modules developer, with commensurate online expertise
- Demonstrated experience and skills in training, including online materials development and implementation
- Experience overseeing training and modules development

Preferred Qualifications:

- Experience in training in different contexts and regions
- An understanding of the universe of human rights and the movement against modern slavery
- Located in one of the regions where FTS is active
